The Commission met in regular session on this date. They signed purchase orders, invoices, two impropers and correspondence on this date.

At 9:00 A.M. the Commission joined with the area mayors and the Elks Lodge in proclaiming March 13-19, 1989, as Wood County Drug Awareness Week.

At 9:30 A.M. Jeff Reed, Prosecuting Attorney, presented his proposed budget to the Commission.

At 10:00 A.M. Mrs. Andrew Bennett met with the Commission. She had been here on Monday, March 6, 1989, at a hearing to close a driveway in Carr Subdivision in Mineral Wells, WV. Mrs. Bennett felt she had been misrepresented by her attorney, Joseph Brown, in that she wanted to give the Somervilles a 16 foot right of way from her property and that would relocate the driveway. This was not mentioned during the hearing on Monday. The Commission advised Mrs. Bennett to discuss this with her attorney, or the Somerville's attorney, David Finnerin.

At 10:30 A.M. the Commission met with Kim Marshall regarding the map situation again.

The Commission authorized Lewis E. Guinn, as President, to sign a letter addressed to the Criminal Justice and Highway Safety Office in Charleston to request the extension of Grant No. DFC-87-011. An Order was prepared for this matter.


Having no further business or scheduled appointments, the Commission adjourned at 12:00 o'clock noon.
