The Commission met in regular session on this date. The first order of business was discussion of the budget with the elected officials.

The Commission signed purchase orders, invoices and correspondence on this date.

At 10:00 A.M. the Commission held a hearing for Doris Powell, alleged Incompetent. Those present were: Debbie Coleman from Parkview Healthcare Center, William Casto, Attorney Robert Full and Gerald Townsend, Guardian Ad Litem. Mrs. Powell resides at Parkview Healthcare Center. She is unable to care for herself in any way. She is a bed patient and also has a tube for feeding. There are no living relatives except for her brother-in-law William Casto. The Commission declared Doris Powell Incompetent.

Since there are no living relatives and Mr. Casto is unwilling to be Committee for Doris Powell, the Commission appointed the Sheriff, Stephen Greiner, to be Committee for Doris Powell.

At 10:30 A.M. there was a hearing scheduled for Golda Heaton, guardianship but no one showed. The Commission met with the elected officials again regarding the budget.

At 11:00 A.M. there was a hearing scheduled for the Peggy Bateman Estate. Attorney Thomas Santer continued indefinitely.

At 11:30 A.M. the Commission met with Fred Early and William Pfalzgraph regarding a resolution and amendment for West Virginia Rehabilitation Services, Inc. doing business as Western Hills Rehabilitation Hospital. The Commission signed the resolution. An Order was prepared.

At 11:45 the Commission swore in John Laughery to the Civil Service Commission.


Having no further business or scheduled appointments, the Commission adjourned at 12:00 Noon.
