IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD  
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 1989

The County Commission of Wood County met in regular session on this date. They signed purchase orders, invoices and correspondence on this date.

At 9:00 A.M. Mary Rader, County Administrator, met with the Commission to discuss various office procedures.

At 10:30 A.M. the Commission had a hearing to re-open the Robert Staley Estate. Joseph Brown was the Attorney. Mr. Brown wants to re-open this estate to show in the appraisal the sale of an interest in the amount of \$100.00 and to do a deed and then to close the estate. Commissioner Shaver made the motion, Commissioner Grimm seconded and President Guinn made it unanimous to re-open this estate.

At 11:00 A.M. the Commission had a hearing for Vivian Louise Webb, alleged incompetent. John Howler of Weston was the Attorney. Jo Ann Murphy, Social Worker was also present. Mrs. Webb was placed in the Weston State Hospital by the Lewis County Mental Hygiene Commission. Commissioner Grimm made the motion, Commissioner Shaver seconded and President Guinn made it unanimous to declare Vivian Louise Webb incompetent. Mrs. Webb's income is \$325.00 a month from Social Security. Commissioner Grimm made the motion, Commissioner Shaver seconded, and President Guinn made it unanimous to appoint S.F. Greiner, Sheriff, Committee for Vivian Louise Webb.

The Commission along with the Mid-Ohio Valley Regional Council had several appointments on this date for the Self-Help Water Projects of Radcliffe Run, Rector Road, Winding Road, Middle Ridge and Mill Run. On the Radcliffe Run, Gene Metz had a petition with 18 families signature, this will require 7,000 ft. of 4" water line, total projected cost is \$14,000.00 to

\$15,000.00. The Commission agreed to help with up to \$5,000.00 on this Project. This is in the Mineral Wells Public Service District.

On Rector Road, Union Williams Public Service District, it will require 3,400 feet of 6" water line for fire protection at a cost of approximately \$25,000.00. The Commission agreed to help with up to \$5,000.00 on this Project.

On Winding Road, Claywood Park Public Service District, Ralph Cross and Mrs. Gates said there would be 12 families but nothing has been completed as of this date. The Commission asked that they have everything ready by January 1, 1990.

On Middle Ridge, Claywood Park Public Service District, Benny Cowan had everything needed for this Project. The Commisison will provide up to \$5,000.00 of the actual cost.

On Mill Run, Don Whitlatch was present and stated that it would be a 4" water line but there was no petition as yet.


Howard Seufer and Annabelle DeLong were present for these meetings for Union Williams Public Service District.

At 1:00 P.M. the Commission and all the elected officials saw a demonstration of the Cannon Car System.


Having no other scheduled appointments or further business to attend to, the Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m.
