The County Commission met in regular session on this date. The Commission signed purchase orders, invoices, correspondence and five improvers on this date.

At 9:00 a.m. the Commission met with County Administrator, Mary Rader, to discuss various office procedures.

At 9:30 a.m. the Commission met with Attorney Bill Pfalzgraf.

At 10:00 a.m. the Commission met with Judith Huber in regard to the signing of a Pre-Application for a Vista Volunteer Outreach Worker. The Commission authorized President Guinn to sign the Pre-Application for the Vista Worker. The Vista Worker will be utilized in conjunction with a previously submitted Drug-Free Communities Grant in the amount of \$25,000.00 sent to the Criminal Justice and Highway Safety Office. An Order was prepared for this matter.

The County Commission met with Fred Rader, from the Mid-Ohio Valley Regional Council and he presented to the Commission Requisition No. 10 and Requisition No. 12 in regard to Claywood Park Public Service District-Deerwalk Project. The County Commission authorized payment of the above requisitions. All documentation pertaining to the Claywood Park Public Service District-Deerwalk Project is on file in the County Administrator's Office. An Order was prepared for this matter.

The County Commission authorized President Guinn to sign a Community Partnership Grant Application in regard to Don Godbey Field Improvements. All documentation pertaining to said Community Partnership Grant is on file

On this date, the County Commission received reimbursement in the amount of \$384.75 from the State of West Virginia in regard to the Drug Law Enforcement Grant No. 88-DLE-011. All documentation pertaining to this Law Enforcement Grant is on file in the County Administrator's Office. An Order was prepared for this matter.

This day came the Petitioners, Margaret L. Trippett, Charles K. Trippett, Robert L. Trippett, Betty Jean Settle, Henry William Miller and Mary Catherine Miller by their Counsel, Phillip J. Trippel, and tendered a Petition seeking the closing of a 20 foot alley a distance of 185 feet and a 15 foot alley a distance of 235 feet located in Tygart District in the P. J. Dollmeyer's Subdivision of a part of Lot No. 2 of Parkersburg Industrial Company's Little Farm's No. 2. The Commission hereby Ordered the petition filed and this matter is hereby set for hearing on the 17th day of May, 1990, at 10:00 a.m., the Petitioners shall cause Notices of said hearing to be published and served as required by law. An Order was prepared for this matter.
