The County Commission of Wood County met in regular session on this date. Purchase orders, correspondence, invoices, and personal property improvers were signed by the Commission.

At 9:00 A.M., Ronald Smith from G.E. Plastics was to be sworn in as a member of the Wood County Airport Authority. Mr. Smith failed to appear and will be sworn in at a later date.

Attorney Thomas R. Zimmerman appeared before the County Commission requesting an appraisal be filed in regard to the Emmett B. Sexton estate. Such an appraisal was filed and all documentation pertaining to said estate is on file in the Probate Office.


The Commission met with Mary R. Rader, County Administrator; Marvin Dowler, Building Inspector; and Gail Hartshorn, Director of Wood County Emergency Services at 1:30 p.m. in regard to the Floodplain Ordinance for Wood County. Following discussion, revisions were made in respect to the definitions of Basement, Existing Manufactured Home Park or Subdivision, Expansion to an Existing Manufactured Home Park or Subdivision, Floodway, Historic Structure, Lowest Floor, Recreational Vehicle, and the inclusion of a Recreational Vehicle Placement. Said revisions were made in accordance with guidelines set forth by FEMA. An Order was prepared in regard to this matter.

Margie Cunningham and Ron Newman, property owners in Clay District, appeared before the Commission at 3:00 p.m. in regard to the assessment of their real property. The Commission referred them to the Assessor's Office.


Being no further business to bring before the Commission, they adjourned at 4:00 p.m.
