The Commission authorized substitution of securities pledged by Wood County Bank. An Order was prepared for this matter.

On this date, Mary Rader, Director of the Wood County

Planning Commission, presented a plat of Scenic Hills Subdivision,

Extension No. 7. Said Extension consists of one (1) lot No. 51,

is located in Clay District and is being developed by Benny G.

McPherson. The Wood County Commission gave approval to the Plat

of Scenic Hills Subdivision. Commission President Guinn signed,

prepared for this matter.

The County Commission authorized President Guinn to sign

Budget Amendment No. 2 in reference to the Union-Williams Public Service District Waverly Sewer Project. Said Amendment entails deducting \$34,200.00 from the Administrative costs and adding the same amount to Construction costs. The Budget Amendment along with a letter of explanation is being mailed to the Governor's Office of Community and Industrial Development, Charleston, WV. All documentation pertaining to the Union-Williams Public Service District Waverly Sewer Project funded through the Small Cities Block Grant is on file in the County Administrator's Office. An Order was prepared for this matter.

At 9:45 a.m. the Commission met with Diana Joachim to discuss her office needing three quotes for the 1990 tax tickets. This will be the first year the form will be used and by using NCR the Tax Office will have a chance to work directly with the designer. The Commission told Mrs. Joachim this would be acceptable for this year. The meeting ended at 9:56 a.m.
