MONDAY, JULY 19, 1990

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed invoices, purchase orders, and correspondence on this date.

At 9:00 a.m. the Commission held an alleged incompetency hearing for Rodney Lynn Satterfield. Harry Deitzler was the attorney. Elizabeth A. Piles was the Guardian ad Litem. R.L. Satterfield is a thirty-one (31) year old male who was involved in an automobile accident December 12, 1989. Due to very serious injuries he is being housed in the Newark Health Care Center in Ohio. His father, Cencil Satterfield is still living. He has four brothers, Dave, Doug, Rob, and Terry. He has five sisters, Connie Hurst, Barbara Irizarry, Betty Boley, Diana Freeland, and Ruth M. Collins. Diana Freeland and Ruth M. Collins were sworn in to give testimony. Ruth M. Collins stated that her brother is unable to talk or write. Elizabeth A. Piles stated that R.L. Satterfield is unable to take care of his financial and physical affairs. Commissioner Grimm moved that Rodney Lynn Satterfield be declared incompetent, Commissioner Shaver seconded the motion and President Guinn made it unanimous. R.L. Satterfield owns no real estate. R.L. Satterfield does have a 1981 Pontiac, a checking account worth \$141.00, and savings account worth \$120.00, a certificate of deposit worth \$470.00, and a monthly Social Security check worth \$483.00. Commissioner Grimm moved that Ruth M. Collins be appointed Committee for Rodney Lynn Satterfield, Commissioner Shaver seconded and President Guinn made it unanimous. Ruth M. Collins is to post a \$5,000.00 bond. The hearing ended at 9:27 a.m. This file is in the Probate Office.

On this date, the Commission met with Williamstown Fabricators concerning back taxes. Eugene A. Knotts, County Assessor agreed to discuss problems and

determine what taxes are owed.

On this date, the Commission entered into an Agreement with the Humane Society of Parkersburg to provide for dogs and cats outside the municipalities of Parkersburg, Vienna and Williamstown. An Order was prepared for this matter.

On this date, the Commission entered into an Additional Agreement with the Humane Society of Parkersburg to provide them with additional compensation. An Order was prepared for this matter.

On this date, the Commission authorized Lewis E. Guinn, President, to enter into a Grant Contract Agreement between the Governor's Office of Community and Industrial Development, Criminal Justice and Highway Safety Office, Charleston, West Virginia, in regard to Grant funds for an Integrated Criminal Apprehension Project. An Order was prepared for this matter.

On this date, the Commission authorized Lewis E. Guinn, President, to enter into a Grant Contract Agreement between the Governor's Office of Community and Industrial Development, Criminal Justice and Highway Safety Office, Charleston, West Virginia, in regard to Grant funds for an Individual Drug Control Project. An Order was prepared for this matter.

On this date, the Commission authorized Lewis E. Guinn to sign the Monthly Financial Report and the Request for Reimbursement for Grant No. 88-DLE-011. An Order was prepared for this matter.

On this date, the Commission authorized Lewis E. Guinn to sign the Monthly Financial Report and Request for Reimbursement for Grant No. DFC-89-055. An Order was prepared for this matter.

On this date, the Commission chose Continental Insurance Company as the County's insurance carrier for County property liability insurance. An Order was prepared for this matter.

At 10:30 a.m. Mr. Eaton from the Public Debt presented Lewis E. Guinn, President with a book, History of the Bureau of Public Debt, 1940-1990, a cook

book, and an engraved bell. This presentation was in celebration of the Public Debt's Fiftieth (50) Anniversary.


Having no other scheduled appointments or further business to attend to, the Commission adjourned at 12:00 p.m.


