On this date, the Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices, correspondence and one (1) improper.

At 10:00 a.m. the Commission held a hearing for Glenola Grace Allen, alleged incompetent. Joe Albright was the Attorney and Gerald Townsend was the Guardian ad Litem. Pauline Bell and Delores Parrish, daughters of Mrs. Allen, were sworn in. Mrs. Allen resides with Pauline Bell. Mrs. Allen's husband, Gerald, passed away May 22, 1990. Mrs. Allen is suffering from Alzheimers Disease and cannot communicate or take care of her own needs. An Affidavit from Dr. Beane and the return of services are in the file. Commissioner Shaver made the motion to declare Glenola Grace Allen incompetent and President Guinn seconded to make it unanimous. Mrs. Allen receives \$595.00 per month Social Security, has approximately \$1,000.00 in checking and lives with her daughter, Pauline Bell, in Davisville, West Virginia. Commissioner Shaver made the motion to appoint Pauline Bell, Committee for Glenola Grace Allen; President Guinn seconded to make it unanimous. A \$6,000.00 Justification Surety Bond is to be posted. This file is in the Probate Office. This hearing ended at 10:25 a.m.

There were no scheduled appointments for the afternoon.


On this date, the Commission received a check from the State of West Virginia in regard to Grant No. B-88-DC-54-0001. An Order was prepared for this matter.
