On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and correspondence on this date.

The Commission had a 9:30 a.m. hearing scheduled for the Resignation of Executor of the Eleanor Westfall Estate. The Attorney, Bruce White, continued this hearing until July 9, 1990, at 9:30 a.m.

At 10:00 a.m. the Commission held an alleged incompetency hearing for K.F. Allen. Louie S. Davitian was the Attorney. George Chandler was the Guardian ad Litem. Mrs. Allen is a forty-seven (47) year old female residing at The Willows Nursing Home. She has suffered from brain tumors, blood clots, and brain cysts for the last few months. She requires twenty-four hour care. She is not capable of taking care of her personal or business needs at this time. Mrs. Allen has two sons, Ray Allen, Jr. and Ronald Allen. Ronald Allen resides in Germany. Ray Allen was sworn in to give testimony. He stated that his mother has been very ill. His mother cannot walk and is in a wheelchair. Commissioner Grimm moved that K.F. Allen be declared incompetent, Commissioner Shaver seconded the motion and President Guinn made it unanimous. Mrs. Allen is purchasing a home at Community Acres. The equity mortgage is \$9,000.00. She has a car which is paid for and receives disability through her work place. Commissioner Grimm moved that Ray Allen, Jr., be appointed Committee for K.F. Allen, Commissioner Shaver seconded and President Guinn made it unanimous. He is to post a \$12,000.00 bond. This hearing ended at 10:11 a.m. This file is in the Probate Office.

On this date, the Commission entered into a Consultation Agreement with Richard Rogers. An Order was prepared for this matter.

On this date, the Commission chose TFN Advanced Digital Long Distance Services, as the Long Distance Service for Wood County. An Order was prepared for this matter.


At 1:00 p.m. the County Commission employees heard the presentation from Capitol American Insurance on their Cancer and Intensive Care Programs.


Having no other scheduled appointments or further business to attend to, the Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m.
