IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD  
MONDAY, OCTOBER 15, 1990

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices, and correspondence.

At 9:00 A.M., the County Commission met with Jack Ankrom to discuss the Magistrate Court Parking Lot Project. They discussed the differences between using asphalt and concrete.

At 10:00 A.M., the Commission heard the case of Louise S. Hixon, alleged incompetent, Attorney Gene Hague. Mrs. Dorothy H. Carpenter wishes to be the Committee for Mrs. Hixon. The County Commission, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver, and made unanimous by Lewis E. Guinn, set the bond at \$1,000.00. Upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver, and made unanimous by Lewis E. Guinn, the County Commission appointed Mrs. Dorothy H. Carpenter as the Committee for Mrs. Hixon.

At 3:30 P.M., Maynard S. Eaton, Jr. was sworn into the Area Round Table.

On this date, Harold Province, postal worker conducting a street naming and property numbering system in Wood County, met with the Commission. Mr. Province requested the Commission to make a decision on street naming beyond I-77. Should he continue numbering with a Seventh Street address or should property numbering beyond I-77 be numbered as George Washington Highway, as it is now known. It was the consensus of the Commission that property numbering beyond I-77 should be known as George Washington Highway.

On this date, Brian Bennett and Randy Meredith, President of Walnut Grove Homeowner's Association, met with the Commission and Mary Rader in regard to the deterioration of a section of road connecting Phase II and Phase III of Walnut Grove Subdivision and whether the developer, C.M. Boso, is liable under

bond to put the road in correctly. Homeowners contend the road was not put in correctly. Information and documentation presented by homeowners will be sent to Assistant Prosecuting Attorney, Robert Waters, who is also legal counsel for the Wood County Planning Commission.


On this date, the County Commission authorized Lewis E. Guinn to enter into a Lease Agreement with the State of West Virginia, Department of Administration. The tenant of such Lease Agreement being the Division of Veterans' Affairs which occupies two rooms on the fourth floor of the Wood County Courthouse. Said Lessee is to pay the Wood County Commission a monthly rent in the amount of \$150.00. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


Having no scheduled appointments or further business to attend to, the Commission adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
