IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 10, 1990

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices, correspondence, and minutes from Thursday, August 2, 1990, Monday, August 6, 1990, and Thursday, August 9, 1990.

At 9:30 A.M., the Commission met with Gail Hartshorn, representing Small Business Association. John Bonberger was also present to discuss a subdivisioned loan program. They also discussed Federal relief for small business and residences in flooded disaster areas.

At 11:00 A.M., the Commission opened sealed bids for remodeling work to be done in the Wood County Courthouse. Bids were received from Gene Metz, bid price: \$3,364.00, and from Jack Reed Contracting, bid price: \$4,855.00. The Commission took under advisement upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver, and made unanimous by Lewis E. Guinn. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

At 11:30 A.M., the Commission opened sealed bids for computers and printers to be used in the Wood County Sheriff's Department. Sealed bids were received from JADE Technologies, Inc., bid price: \$27,790.00, Trudy Corr, bid price: \$44,586.65, BSSI, bid price: \$35,221.69 and \$41,062.75, Montgomery Ward, bid price: \$16,088.86, and \$15,399.86. The Commission upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by Steven A. Grimm, and made unanimous by Lewis E. Guinn, took the above bids under advisement. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

At 1:00 P.M., the Commission met with Mike Shea from the West Central Regional Juvenile Detention Center. They discussed the problems they are having with the fire alarm system and decided to take one from the Child Care Center

to see if this one will fit.


At 2:00 P.M., the Commission met with Fred Rader concerning the Community Partnership Grant for the Williamstown Emergency ambulance. Said Grant was signed upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by Steven A. Grimm, and made unanimous by Lewis E. Guinn. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


