At 9:45 A.M., the Commission met with Jack Ankrom of RJ Ankrom Associates, to discuss the parking lot at Magistrate Court. Mr. Ankrom provided the Commission with the plans for this parking area. The Commission gave authority to go to bid in regard to the Wood County Magistrate Court Parking Lot Project. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

At 10:00 A.M., the Commission met with Curtis Dickson from the Mid Ohio Valley Health Department. Mr. Dickson discussed the repairs that need to be done in the Health Department. Mr. Dickson asked the Commission to help with the cost of the repairs. The Commission took this under advisement and will respond to this matter in one week.

At 11:00 A.M., the Commission authorized Lewis E. Guinn to enter into an Agreement by and between the Wood County Commission and Precision Cleaning Systems. Said Agreement is for janitorial services to be provided at the Wood County Judicial Building. David Parker represented Precision Cleaning. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

At 1:00 P.M., the Commission met with Bob Waters, Assistant Prosecuting Attorney to discuss Victory Street.

At 3:00 P.M., the Commission upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver, and made unanimous by Lewis E. Guinn, decided to continue to keep Victory Street open and disallow the Petition to close.

An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the Commission received notification from the Criminal Justice and Highway Safety Office, State of West Virginia, of approval for a time extension in regard to the Sobriety Checkpoints Grant No. AI88-11. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.
