On this date, the County Commission appointed James R. Lett to the Mineral Wells Public Service District Board. Mr. Lett will fill the unexpired term of Tonie D. Cottrell. Mr. Lett's term will be from December 11, 1991 through July 16, 1993. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.




Having no scheduled appointments or further business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
