On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and correspondence. They approved Personal Property Improvers for Stephen D. Williams, Jeff M. Allen, Kenneth L. and Megan M. Pugh.

At 9:00 A.M., Mayor Owens failed to show for his appointment for an update of the Riverfront Park.

At 10:06 A.M., the County Commission went into Executive Session. In attendance were Darrin Yearego, Patrick McMullen, David Joy, S.F. Greiner, Mark Rhodes, Jeff Reed and the Commissioners. The Executive Session was to discuss a suit against certain Correctional Officers. They adjourned at 10:28 A.M.

At 11:00 A.M., the County Commission met with Jeff Reed to discuss his maintenance agreement for his computers. Mr. Reed also discussed another option that he is going to check into. He will let the Commissioners know what he finds out. The Commissioners agreed with this. Mr. Reed also wanted to discuss the purchase of a new copier for his office. Commissioner Grimm stated that he thinks that Mr. Reed should shop for prices on what he wants and if it is necessary to go out for bid then they will.

At 11:30 A.M., the County Commission authorized Steven A. Grimm to co-sign along with Judith Sutton, a letter addressed to the Criminal Justice and Highway Safety Office in regard to the Drug Free Communities Grant No. DFC-90-104. Said letter requests that the remaining amount of \$408.34 in the Travel/Training category be transferred to the Material and Supplies category. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of a letter from Frederick H. Powell who was requesting to be re-appointed to the Wood County Airport

Authority.

On this date, the County Commission approved a Personal Property Improper for Auke L. Tuinstra and an Exoneration for Paul C. Hoblitzell, IV.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of the Notice of a Conditional Approval of the Levy Estimate from the State of West Virginia, Department of Tax and Revenue, in regard to the budget for Wood County for the fiscal year 1991/1992. A letter concerning Account numbers 322 and 372 was also submitted. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of the fully executed Contract No. CWEP-92-06-06 by and between the County Commission and the Parkersburg Area No. 6 of the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources in regard to the Community Work Experience Program. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of the approval of the Request for Revision to Approved Budget from the Department of Tax and Revenue, State of West Virginia in regard to Revision Nos. 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.






Having no scheduled appointments or further business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 12:00 Noon.
