

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD
MONDAY, MARCH 18, 1991

On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and correspondence.

At 9:00 A.M., the County Commission met with Jamie Six and Ron Jalbert to discuss handicap accessibility of polling precincts.

At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission heard the case of Howard Riggs, alleged incompetent. Frank Yoke, Attorney presented the case. Joe Brown, Guardian Ad Litem was also present and stated that he agrees with the petition concerning Mr. Riggs' physical state. Mr. Yoke presented a letter from Dr. Godlewski stating that Mr. Riggs was in a permanent vegetative state. Shirley J. Riggs, wife of Mr. Riggs, stated that Mr. Riggs is 61 years old, has had a kidney removed, then in 1986 had a transplant, which put him into Cardiac Arrest and it left him in this vegetative state. He does not communicate. Mrs. Riggs has been caring for him. Upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by Jean Grapes and made unanimous by Steven A. Grimm, the Commission declared Mr. Riggs incompetent. The County Commission appointed Mrs. Shirley Riggs as Committee with a minimum property bond of \$1,000.00. The Commission will also pay Joe Brown, Guardian Ad Litem \$50.00.

At 10:30 A.M., the County Commission met with Ishmael Johnson and members of the Wood County Community Association. They wish to have a representative from the Assessor's Office, the State Tax Department and Trumble Systems and Service Incorporated meet with them to discuss the CAMA being used with the reappraisal. They think that the people are being treated improperly. Commissioner Grimm stated that they will do whatever they can to get these people here. The Association stated that TSSI and the Assessor are doing what the State

Tax Department tells them to do. Commissioner Grimm stated that he thinks the CAMA system is an excellent one. The Commission stated that they will try to get the representatives from the three groups or the State Tax Commission to be present at a future meeting.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of a County Ambulance Listing from the Mid-Ohio Valley Emergency Medical Services. The total number of allocated ambulances for Wood County is twelve plus one four wheel drive. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission authorized Holmes R. Shaver, as President Pro Tem, to sign the Monthly Progress Report No. 7 for the month of February, 1991, the Equipment Listing and the Request For Reimbursement in regard to Drug Control and System Improvement Grant No. 90-DC-028. The Request For Reimbursement is in the amount of \$352.90 which represents payment to Jade Technologies, Inc. for materials ordered for the use with the computer purchased through the above Grant. In addition to the Monthly Progress Report, the Equipment Listing and the Request For Reimbursement, a Project Financial Report is being submitted to the Criminal Justice and Highway Safety Office, Charleston, WV. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.






Having no scheduled appointments or further business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 12:00 Noon.
