

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD  
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 1991

PRESENT: PRESIDENT STEVEN A. GRIMM  
COMMISSIONER HOLMES R. SHAVER

ABSENT: COMMISSIONER JEAN GRAPES

On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and correspondence.

At 9:00 A.M., Benny Stump was sworn in as a member of the Wood County Recreation Commission.

At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission held a hearing for Joseph Soriano, alleged incompetent. The Attorney was Scott Durig and the Guardian Ad Litem was Joe Brown. Adrienne Davis, a registered nurse at Parkview Health Care Center was sworn in. Ms. Davis stated that Mr. Soriano has been at the Center for approximately 18 years; he is relatively healthy; he gets confused sometimes and hallucinates; he can eat and take care of himself if reminded; he can not take care of his business affairs. An affidavit was received from Dr. Allan Figueroa. Mr. Brown visited Mr. Soriano and found that he didn't know about his property or income and he was confused. Mr. Brown stated that he agrees with the Petition. Upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by Steven A. Grimm, and passed, declared Joseph Soriano incompetent. Mr. Soriano has no real property or personal property. He does have a funeral trust. He receives a Social Security check in the amount of \$251.90 and a Veteran's check for \$884.00 per month. The fee of Parkview is \$1,028.00 per month. Mr. Soriano has seven children who are scattered around the U.S. Upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by Steven A. Grimm, and passed, the County Commission appointed Sheriff Greiner as Committee for Joseph Soriano.

At 10:30 A.M., the County Commission held a hearing for Mabel Parsons,

alleged incompetent. Attorney was Scott Durig and Guardian Ad Litem was Joe Brown. Adrienne Davis, a registered nurse at Parkview Health Care Center was sworn in. Mr. Durig stated that Ernest, the only living son was informed of this hearing. Ms. Davis stated that her health is slowly deteriorating; she talks to herself; is confused; she is blind and can't take care of herself. An affidavit from Dr. Allan Figueroa was received. Joe Brown stated that she was confused when he visited her and that he agrees with the Petition. Upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by Steven A. Grimm and passed, the County Commission declared Mabel Parsons incompetent. Ms. Parsons' only income is her Social Security. Upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by Steven A. Grimm and passed, the County Commission appointed Sheriff Greiner as Committee for Mabel Parsons.

At 11:30 A.M., the County Commission met with Judith Sutton, from Mountain State College. The County Commission authorized Steven A. Grimm to sign the Request for Reimbursement and the Final Financial Report in regard to the Drug Free Communities Grant No. DFC-89-055. Expenditures in the amount of \$1,451.80 were made by Wood County during the month of August. In addition to the Request for Reimbursement and the Final Financial Report, a Final Progress Report is being submitted to the Criminal Justice and Highway Safety Office. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

At 1:15 P.M., the County Commission visited Magistrate Court to observe the area that will be storage of juvenile records for Circuit Clerk's office.

At 2:00 P.M., the County Commission discussed Exonerations. They approved Exonerations for Janet Sue and James L. Rutherford, Ronald D. and Lucinda Schnell, Arleen Phillips, Juanita M. Tuttle, Donald E. Clark, and Joseph J. and Evelyn J. Domain.

On this date, the County Commission approved an Amended Order in regard to health insurance for new employees. Health insurance coverage for new employees will become effective the first day of the month of the month in

which the ninety day waiting period has been satisfied. An Order was prepared regarding this matter. (Nunc pro tunc September 12, 1991)

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of a letter from Atlantic Financial, advising them of a substitution of collateral pledged as a County Depository. A U.S. Treasury Bill due October 31, 1991 in the amount of \$200,000.00 is being substituted for a U.S. Treasury Bill due September 12, 1991 in the amount of \$200,000.00 as stated in said letter. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and passed, appointed Nina Affolter, Democrat, to the Wood County Civil Service Commission for Correctional Officers. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


