On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and correspondence. They also approved a Personal Property Improper for Sampson and Deborah Keller.

At 10:00 A.M., all parties concerned failed to show for the Jessie B. Craig bond removal.

At 10:30 A.M., the County Commission met with Marvin Mollohan to discuss getting a right of way for a gas line which would be on Wood County property. Mr. Mollohan stated that the National Guard and the Wood County Airport Authority have no problem with him putting his gas line through this property. The Commission told Mr. Mollohan that he would need a survey from the Gas Company and also have an agreement made stating his intentions (a legal description). The agreement should also state that Mr. Mollohan will remove it at his own expense if it hinders future development. Commissioner Shaver stated that they have no problem with this.

On this date, the County Commission announced to all concerned, that they, as a Commission, are calling a SPECIAL SESSION to be held on Tuesday, April 7, 1991 at 8:30 A.M., for the purpose of approving the Democrat and Republican Lists of Poll Workers, for the Primary Election to be held in the County of Wood on May 12, 1992. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.



