IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD
MONDAY, JANUARY 6, 1992

On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and correspondence. The Commission approved Personal Property Improvers for William A. & Sharon Niday, Paul G. & Patricia Sandy and D&S Inc.

Upon a motion made by Jean Grapes, seconded by Steven A. Grimm and made unanimous by Holmes R. Shaver, the County Commission approved minutes from Monday, December 16, 1991. Upon a motion made by Jean Grapes, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and made unanimous by Steven A. Grimm, the County Commission approved minutes from Monday, December 9, 1991 and Thursday, December 12, 1991.

At 9:00 A.M., the County Commission met with Mary Rader, Administrator, to discuss County business.

At 1:30 P.M., the County Commission met with Diana Joachim from the Sheriff's Tax Office, to discuss the tax statements. Mrs. Joachim had previously requested that the Commission allow the State Tax Department do the forms at a cost of \$1500.00. Mrs. Joachim stated that the cost for her employees to work overtime would be \$850.00 plus benefits. This would be for sixty hours which would be one full Saturday and four to five evenings. She stated that this is how it has been for the last two years. Mrs. Joachim stated that they have from June 7, 1992 to July 15, 1992 to have them done. President Grimm stated that he would rather pay overtime instead of paying the \$1500.00. Mrs. Joachim stated that they would still need to get cable to have the printers all on one floor. Commissioner Grapes stated that she

would rather pay our employees here in Wood County the overtime. The Commission asked the price of a burster, which the County does not have, but uses the City of Parkersburg's. Mrs. Joachim stated that it would be \$3,000.00.

At 3:30 P.M., James Lett was sworn in as a member of the Mineral Wells Public Service District Board.

On this date, the County Commission reappointed Charles H. Huffman, Jr. to the Lubeck Public Service District Board, upon a motion made by Jean Grapes, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and made unanimous by Steven A. Grimm. Mr. Huffman's term will expire on December 31, 1997. An Order was prepared regarding this matter. Mr. Huffman was also sworn in on this date.

On this date, the County Commission ORDERED that the fees for keeping and maintaining prisoners in the Wood County Correctional Center (Jail) for the months of January, February and March, 1992 will be \$36.30 per prisoner per day. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission placed into nomination for the vacancies that exist on the Wood County Planning Commission the following: Charles D. Peck, Ferris M. Nedeff and Freddie Fields. The County Commission also placed into nomination the following members who wish to be reappointed: Robert Stephens, Richard Wilhelm, Larry Border, Paul M. Campbell, Harold Province and Cynthia Brown. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of the attached Order filed in the U.S. District Court, Southern District of West Virginia in reference to Ebert Mark Cross, Plaintiff, v. County Commission of Wood County, Sheriff Stephen Greiner, Chief Jail Administrator Mark Rhodes, and Lt. R. Nelson, Defendants-Civil Action No. A:91-1215. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of an Order filed in the U.S. District Court, Southern District of WV, in reference to Brian




