THURSDAY, APRIL 29, 1993

On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

On this date, the County Commission approved Exonerations for O. Eugene Hoschar and Frank & Carol Reynolds. The County Commission also approved Personal Property Improvers for Linda L. Jones and Richard L. & Linda Maley.

At 11:00 A.M., President Shaver met with Mark Epler to discuss the assessment of his property.

On this date, the County Commission, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Jean Grapes and passed, adopted a Resolution in reference to Budget Revision No. 20 in the General County Fund budget for the fiscal year 1992/1993. The Request for Revision, being submitted to the Department of Tax and Revenue, Charleston, WV, was signed by Holmes R. Shaver, President of the County Commission. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission announced a vacancy on the Wood County Parks and Recreation Commission (Mountwood Park) due to Clarence Hackett not wishing to be on said board. Mr. Hackett's term would have expired on December 16, 1995. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission, upon a motion made by Jean Grapes, seconded by Steven A. Grimm and made unanimous by Holmes R. Shaver, reappointed Daniel A. Ruley, Jr. to the Parkersburg/Wood County Public Library. The term of office will be from July 1, 1993 through June 30, 1998. Mr. Ruley was nominated by Order dated April 19, 1993. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission, upon a motion made by Jean Grapes, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and made unanimous by Steven A. Grimm, signed a Quit-Claim Deed by and between the County Commission of Wood County, WV, and Edith F. Parker, widow, conveying one-half interest of a fifteen foot alley situated, lying and being on the westerly side of right of way, which fifteen foot alley is 15' x 48.94', which abuts the property owned by Edith F. Parker, widow, William Donald Allman and Marjorie A. Allman, husband and wife; and Donald E. Davy and Cheri Davy, husband and wife. The said 15' x 48.94' alley ends at the property owned by William and Marjorie Allman, husband and wife. The signing of said Quit-Claim Deed is pursuant to an Order entered by the County Commission on March 25, 1993 at which time the Commission, following the duly advertised public hearing, closed the said 15 x 48.94' alley. Said Order appearing in Order Book 55, at Page 333. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission also signed a Quit-Claim Deed by and between the County Commission and Donald E. Davy and Cheri Davy, husband and wife, conveying one-half interest of the above-mentioned 15' alley. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Jean Grapes and made unanimous by Holmes R. Shaver, signed a Proclamation proclaiming the week of May 9-15, 1993 as Senior Center Week. The County Commission also signed a Proclamation proclaiming the month of May as Older Americans Month. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.



Paul Reese (due to the fact that Clarence Hackett, who was appointed, did not wish to serve on the board) which will expire on December 16, 1995 and Mr. Lowther will be filling the unexpired term of Ronald Buchanan which will expire on December 16, 1994. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


Having no scheduled appointments or further business to attend, the County Commission adjourned at 12:00 Noon.
