IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD
THURSDAY, JANUARY 7, 1993

On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence. Upon a motion made Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Jean Grapes and passed, the County Commission approved minutes from Thursday, December 31, 1992 and Monday, January 4, 1993.

On this date, Mike Perry owner of Perry's Alignment met with the County Commission to ask for a variance. Mr. Perry stated that his business is below the Floodplain and he has met the stipulations that were required of him. He now needs a showroom and waiting area, which would need to be a six foot high addition. Commissioner Grapes stated that the County can't violate FEMA laws by granting him a variance. Gail Hartshorn, Wood County Emergency Services, stated that the County would be put on probation if FEMA would check records and find out about it. Mr. Perry stated that there is a grandfather clause. Mr. Hartshorn stated that the grandfather clause ended in 1985. Mr. Hartshorn suggested that they get in touch with FEMA. Commissioner Grimm agreed to this and asked Mr. Perry to get in touch with the Commission next Thursday, January 14, 1993.

On this date, Gary Parsons, Wood County Sheriff's Department requested \$650.00 for blacktop repair on the parking lot behind the Law Enforcement Building. The County Commission told Mr. Parsons that they would take a look at the parking lot and get in touch with him.

On this date, the County Commission announced a vacancy on the Wood County Emergency Services Board due to the expiration of Michael Moore's term expiring February 1, 1993. Upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded


by Jean Grapes and passed, the County Commission placed Mr. Moore in nomination to be reappointed to said Board. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


On this date an Amended Order was prepared in regard to Theodore Davitian's term for the Wood County Civil Service Commission for Correctional Officers. The expiration date of his term should be Amended to read the 28th day of July, 1996, instead of the 5th day of February, 1996.
