At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission met with Robert Hill and Pat Lawrence. They wanted to thank the Commission for supporting Artsbridge and stated that they are not asking for an increase in funding. Ms. Lawrence informed the Commission of what Artsbridge is currently doing such as the submarine display and different programs.

At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission met with Michael Rolston to advise the County Commission that they are trying to get a grant application for the Williamstown Railroad Station Restoration through the Department of Transportation. Mr. Rolston asked the Commission to prepare a letter or letters of support, which the Commission agreed to do.

At 10:30 A.M., the County Commission met with the Employee Benefit Committee. The Committee presented proposed changes to the Wood County Personnel Policy. Said changes is attached to these minutes.

On this date, the County Commission, upon a motion made by Jean Grapes, seconded by Steven A. Grimm and made unanimous by Holmes R. Shaver, did review the Levy Estimate (Budget) for 1993/1994, and approved the same and instructed the Clerk of this Commission to mail one copy to the State Tax Commissioner, and cause the same to be published in two newspapers of general circulation of opposite politics once a week for two consecutive weeks. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.






Having no scheduled appointments or further business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
