On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

On this date, the County Commission approved Exonerations for Robert L. & Naomi J. Clifford, Larry E. & Gloria K. Smith and Gary W. & Okeema A. Traugh.

On this date, the County Commission approved Personal Property Improvers for Stephen S. Martin, Kelly J. & Sandra K. Sheppard, Audrey R. Martin and Carl D. & Patricia D. Hill.

At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission met to discuss the guardianship of Lisa and Mary Stevens. Lisa is 15 years of age and her guardians are now Brenda K. & D. Jean Adams (with a \$100.00 bond). Mary is 17 years of age and her guardians are now Timmy R. Williams and Carolyn S. Williams (with a \$100.00 bond).

At 10:15 A.M., the County Commission met with Tony Meehl to discuss the Otis Elevator agreements. After some discussion, Mr. Meehl stated that he felt there was no problem with how the agreements were handled.

At 1:30 P.M., the County Commission met with Eugene Knotts and Jamie Six, who discussed the updating of the index cards in regard to transfers. They would like to hire another person to update the cards that are two and a half years behind. Mr. Knotts stated that they would need a full-time employee. Mr. Six stated that he feels that the employee should be hired by either the County Commission or Mr. Knotts. Commissioner Grapes suggested the County Commission might hire the employee. Commissioner Grapes then suggested that the County Commission take this under advisement, this was seconded by Steven A. Grimm.




Having no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
