IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 14, 1994

On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed invoices and other correspondence.


At 11:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Jean Grapes and made unanimous by Holmes R. Shaver, ORDERED that the Public Hearing scheduled for this date be CONTINUED, up to sixty days from this date, to allow Charles R. Buskirk, Petitioner, to purchase Lot Number Two of the Hillsdale Addition from Robert Atkinson. Continuance of such Public Hearing is pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 56, at Page 108 and bearing the date of October 24, 1994 at which time the Public Hearing scheduled on that date was continued until this date, November 14, 1994 due to a misunderstanding of the notification to adjoining property owners. On this date, notice of service was presented to the County Commission by return receipt of the mailing by Certified Mail to Robert Atkinson, Leonard Watson and Sadler Landscaping. The County Commission ORDERED that said notice of service be filed. Charles R. Buskirk originally petitioned the County Commission on October 3, 1994 to close an undeveloped and dead end road approximately five hundred twenty feet (520') in length and forty feet (40') in width known as 45th Street located in Parkersburg District, Wood County, West Virginia. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of the Statements of Accounts from the Trust Division of the Huntington National Bank West Virginia, Parkersburg, West Virginia, for the Courthouse Annex Account, the Principal Account and the Interest Account in regard to the Wood County Building Commission (Wood County Courthouse Annex Project) Series 1992 Bond Issue. The said Statements of Accounts are for the period of July 1, 1994 through October 31, 1994. All documentation pertaining to the said Building Commission Bond Issue is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


Having no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
