On this date, the County Commission met in Special Session.

The County Commission, upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by Jean Grapes and passed, having ascertained that the net amount necessary to be raised by the Levy of Taxes for the Current Year for County current purposes will be Five Million Seven Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars (\$5,764,822.00) according to the estimate and entered of record on the 28th day of March, 1995. Said estimate having been published as required by law, and no one appearing to oppose this Commission or to take exception thereto, and the State Tax Commissioner having heretofore by a letter received by this Commission on the 13th day of April, 1995, approved said Levy Estimate as submitted, it is therefore ORDERED that said Estimate and the Rates of Levy proposed therein, be approved and the following levies be laid on each One Hundred Dollars valuation of each Class of Property: VIZ


11.40 cents of Class I Property
22.80 cents of Class II Property
45.60 cents of Class III Property
45.60 cents of Class IV Property

For the purpose of aforesaid, being based upon the raised assessment thereon, the Levy Order and Levy Rate Sheet are attached to these minutes and should be made a part thereof.

Having finished the business at hand, the County Commission adjourned at 9:00 A.M.
