MONDAY, MARCH 6, 1995

On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

On this date, the County Commission, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and passed, approved Board of Review and Equalization minutes from Friday, February 10, 1995 and Wednesday, February 15, 1995.

On this date, the County Commission approved Personal Property Improvers for E.L. Starcher - Lubeck District and William & Lisa Smith - City District.

On this date, the County Commission approved Exonerations for Roy S. & Sharon R. Phillips - Parkersburg; Ralph L. & Emily J. Matheny - City District and Gregory & Susan Rogers - Walker District.

At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission met with S.F. Greiner, Assessor, to discuss his proposed budget for fiscal year 1995/1996. Mr. Greiner asked if the Commission had any questions. President Grapes asked Mr. Greiner if he asked for any increases. Mr. Greiner stated that he asked for a less than 4% increase in the salary line item which is to keep up with the cost of living.

At 10:30 A.M., the County Commission met with Lyndall Jones, WVU Extension Agent, to discuss his proposed budget for fiscal year 1995/1996. Mr. Jones stated that there are a few changes from last year because the Board of Education is still working on their budget;

would like to see an increase in salary and the office needs a new copier.

At 10:45 A.M., the County Commission met with Carole Jones, Circuit Clerk to discuss her proposed budget for fiscal year 1995/1996.

At 11:00 A.M., the County Commission met with K.D. Merritt, Sheriff; Charlie Johnson, Chief Deputy; Mark Rhodes, Jail Administrator; Robert Tranquill; Chief Tax Deputy and Vickie Cummons, Tax Deputy.

At 1:30 P.M., the County Commission met with Charisse Straight and Sam Winans from the Humane Society to discuss their budget.

On this date, came Michele Rusen, Prosecuting Attorney for Wood County, and presented to the County Commission of Wood County an Application in which it is requested that the Honorable Gaston Caperton, governor of the State of West Virginia, issue a requisition on the Governor of the State of Florida for the extradition of Terry Lee Carpenter, who stands charged with the crime of Theft of a Rental Vehicle, committed in the County of Wood, of the State of West Virginia, in January, 1995 and who is now a fugitive from justice of the State of West Virginia and, as the Prosecuting Attorney is informed, is now within the jurisdiction of the said State of Florida, in the County of Pinellas, and the City of Clearwater. Upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, Seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and passed, the County Commission of Wood County gave approval to Jean Grapes, in her official capacity as President and on behalf of the County Commission, to sign the said Application for extradition. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a

motion duly made, seconded and passed, ORDERED that Exoneration No. 4235, found in Order Book 57, at Page 585 and bearing the date of February 16, 1995, pertaining to real property be VOIDED due to incorrect information. As per the Assessor's Office, a new Exoneration will be prepared. Said Exoneration was in the name of Ida Baxter and is in Union District. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


Having no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
