IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD
MONDAY, MARCH 27, 1995

On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission held a hearing in regard to the Robert M. Allen Estate. Attorney James Bradley was present and informed the Commission that he was contacted by Attorney Jeffrey Haines, in Cleveland, Ohio for the purposes of establishing the estate of Mr. Allen. Mr. Bradley stated Mr. Allen was a resident in Wood County but died in a automobile accident in 1994 in the state of Ohio; he is presenting an application to open estate; he is survived by his wife and two children, two parents and a sister; Mr. Haines told Mr. Bradley that none of these people are interested in handling the estate; therefore, according to WV Code the County Commission should appoint the Sheriff to handle the affairs; there may be an insurance policy. Upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and made unanimous by Jean Grapes, the County Commission appointed the Sheriff, on behalf of Robert Marshall Allen, deceased, to act as the probate on behalf of this estate.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, in regular session, announced to all concerned, upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by Steven A. Grimm and made unanimous by Jean Grapes, that they, as a Commission, are calling for a SPECIAL SESSION to be held on Tuesday, March 28, 1995 from 9:00 A.M. to 9:30 A.M.

Said Special Session is in regard to the preparation of the budget for the fiscal year 1995/1996, as required by Chapter 11, Article 8, Section 10, of the West Virginia Code of 1931, as amended. This meeting will be held in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared and posted in regard to this matter.


On this date, the County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of an Order entered in the Circuit Court of Wood County, West Virginia in regard to Christian Parton, and infant, Case Number 95-D-47. A copy of the Circuit Order is attached to the County Commission Order that was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and made unanimous by Jean Grapes, announced to all concerned, that they as a Commission, will not be in session on Monday, April 17, 1995 and Thursday, April 20, 1995. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

Having no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
