

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD  
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 27, 1995

On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

On this date, the County Commission, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Jean Grapes and passed, approved minutes from Monday, October 30, 1995.

On this date, came Michele Rusen, Prosecuting Attorney for Wood County, and presented to the County Commission of Wood County an Application in which it is requested that the Honorable Gaston Caperton, Governor of West Virginia, issue a requisition on the Governor of the State of Ohio for the extradition of William McCabe, who stands charged with the crime of Attempting to Obtain a Controlled Substance by Fraud or Forgery, two counts, and Obtaining a Controlled Substance by Fraud or Forgery, two counts, committed in the County of Wood, of the State of West Virginia, in July, 1995 and who is now a fugitive from justice of the State of West Virginia and, as the Prosecuting Attorney is informed, is now within the jurisdiction of the State of Ohio, in the County of Washington, and the City of Marietta. The date of birth of said William McCabe is July 1, 1949, social security number [REDACTED], a white male, height six feet (6'), one hundred sixty-five (165) pounds, brown hair and blue eyes. Upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, the County Commission of Wood County did hereby AUTHORIZE

Jean Grapes, in her official capacity as President and on behalf of the County Commission, to sign the said Application of Prosecuting Attorney. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission approved the purchase of a roller shelving unit in the amount of \$1,420.81 for the County Clerk's Office.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County did hereby DENY the Petition presented by Petitioners Gerald M. Shaffer and Grace K. Shaffer. The said Petition requests the opening of an alley right of way between 32nd Street and 33rd Street located in Williams Taxing District, Wood County, West Virginia outside the Municipality of Vienna and further requests that the aforementioned Petitioners be allowed to improve the said right of way with three (3) inches of slag as per the previous inspection and recommendation of the County Inspector, Gail Hartshorn. (An Amending Order appearing in Order Book 56, at Page 342 and bearing the date of November 16, 1995 changes the improvement of the right of way from three (3) inches of slag to four (4) inches of crushed stone or slag to be spread and rolled to proper crown and contour and a second layer of two (2) inches of crushed stone or slag to be spread and rolled in accordance with the Subdivision Regulations for Wood County.) On this date, and following the Public Hearing held by the County Commission of Wood County in regard to the aforementioned Petition, on Thursday, November 16, 1995 and in which objections were voiced by abutting property owners and the Mayor of the City of Vienna, William F. Owens, a motion was made by Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by Steven A.

Grimm and made unanimous by Jean Grapes to DENY the aforementioned Petition to make improvements to the said alley right of way based on the provision that the improvements would not benefit all abutting property owners as set forth in Chapter 7, Article 1, Section 3a of the Code of West Virginia 1931, as amended. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, ORDERED that Exoneration No. 4309, found in Order Book 56, at Page 326 and bearing the date of October 12, 1995, pertaining to real property be VOIDED due to an incorrect name. As per the Assessor's Office, a new Exoneration will be prepared. Said Exoneration is in the name of Charles Root, is for the year 1995 and is in Walker District. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of a letter from Gaston Caperton, Governor of West Virginia, in which the Honorable Gaston Caperton is informing the County Commission of Wood County of the approval of funding in the amount of sixty thousand dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$60,000.00) in regard to the Comprehensive Traffic Safety Program Grant. Receipt of such letter is pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 56, at Page 305 and bearing the date of August 28, 1995 at which time the County Commission of Wood County signed a Resolution authorizing the filing of an Application through the West Virginia Department of Military Affairs and Public Safety, Criminal Justice and Highway Safety Office, for the purpose of applying for Highway Safety funds,


Sections 402 and 410. All documentation pertaining to the said Comprehensive Traffic Safety Program Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of the Grant Adjustment Notice from the Criminal Justice and Highway Safety Office, Charleston, WV, in regard to the time extension of the supplemental award in the amount of six thousand five hundred eighty-seven dollars and no cents (\$6,587.00) for the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant Number 94-JJ-7-013. With the approval of the aforementioned supplemental award, the revised total award is in the amount of twenty-one thousand five hundred eighty-seven dollars and no cents (\$21,587.00), and the aforementioned time extension extends the said Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant to August 31, 1996. Receipt of said Grant Adjustment Notice is pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 56, at Page 278 and bearing the date of July 20, 1995 at which time the letter of request was signed by Steven A. Grimm, President Pro Tem of the Wood County Commission. All documentation pertaining to the said Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


Having no scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
