On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

On this date, the County Commission approved Personal Property Improvers for Jean A. Campbell - City District; Kimberly Furner - Tygart District; and Alfred S. & Juanita M. Thomas - Clay District.

On this date, the County Commission approved Exonerations for David W. & Beth A. Hudkins - Clay District; M.A. Hall - Harris District; Consolidated Gas - Volcanic #1 & 1225 - Walker District; Douglas A. Boggs - City District; Ralph L. Deem - City District; Jack W. & Carol J. Ewing - Walker District; Pennzoil Co. - Clay District; Le Etta M. Dawkins - City District; and Grace K. Shaffer - Williams District.

At 11:00 A.M., the County Commission met with Toni Tiano and Tim Knopp, grant consultants to discuss the following grants. The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and made unanimous by Jean Grapes, did hereby ORDER that a Resolution be adopted that would authorize the filing of an Application by the President of the County Commission, Jean Grapes, for a Grant with the West Virginia Department of Military Affairs and Public Safety, Criminal Justice and Highway Safety Office, Charleston, West Virginia, for the purpose of applying for a Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant. The said

Grant Application, attached to the Resolution, requests funding for a part-time Specialized Case Worker on a contractual basis to develop after-care treatment plans for those youths returning to the community from out-of-home placements. Such specialized Case Worker would work out of the Office of the Wood County Juvenile Probation Office. The said Application and all documentation pertaining to the aforementioned Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and made unanimous by Jean Grapes, did hereby ORDER that a Resolution be adopted that would authorize the filing of an Application by the President of the County Commission, Jean Grapes, for a Grant with the West Virginia Department of Military Affairs and Public Safety, Criminal Justice and Highway Safety Office, Charleston, West Virginia, for the purpose of applying for a Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant. The said Grant Application requests the continuance of the Youth In Effective Legal Diversion Program (Y.I.E.L.D.) which is being administered by the Wood County Juvenile Probation Office. The said Application and all documentation pertaining to the aforementioned Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.




as President and on behalf of the County Commission, to sign the letter addressed to the Criminal Justice and Highway Safety Office, Charleston, WV, in which it is requested that a budget revision be approved in regard to the Comprehensive Traffic Safety Program Grant Number 95HS-07. The said letter requests that the amount of fifty-six dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$56.00) be transferred from the Travel/Training Category to the Equipment Category, and further requests that the amount of forty dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$40.00) be transferred from the Travel/Training Category to the Other Category. Approval of such revisions would allow the Program Coordinators (Tiano-Knopp Associates, Inc.) to attend some recently scheduled meetings involving the Highway Safety Program. All documentation pertaining to the said Comprehensive Traffic Safety Program Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

Having no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 12:00 Noon.
