At 8:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in Special Session.

The County Commission, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and made unanimous by Jean Grapes, having ascertained that the net amount necessary to be raised by The Levy of Taxes for the Current Year for County current purposes will be Six Million Three Hundred Two Thousand Six Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$6,302,670.00) according to the estimate and entered of record on the 15th day of April, 1996 (nunc pro tunc March 28, 1996). Said estimate having been published as required by law, and no one appearing to oppose this Commission or to take exception thereto, and the State Tax Commissioner having heretofore by a letter received by this Commission on the 11th day of April, 1996, approved said Levy Estimate as submitted, it is therefore ORDERED that said Estimate and the Rate of Levy proposed therein, be approved and the following levies be laid on each One Hundred Dollars valuation of each Class of Property:


11.33 cents of Class I Property
22.66 cents of Class II Property
45.32 cents of Class III Property
45.32 cents of Class IV Property

For the purpose of aforesaid, being based upon the raised assessment thereon, the Levy Order and the Levy Rate Sheet are attached to the Order that was prepared regarding this matter.


The County Commission adjourned at 8:45 A.M.


