On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

On this date, came Mary R. Rader, Director of the Wood County Planning Commission, and presented to the County Commission of Wood county a plat of Lot 124 A, First Revision of Scenic Hills Subdivision, Extension 9 located in Clay District and being developed by Benny G. McPherson. The plat of the aforementioned Lot 124 A, was given approval by the Wood County Planning Commission at their March 6, 1996 meeting. All utilities are provided to the said Scenic Hills Subdivision, the roadways are completed in accordance with the Subdivision Regulations and a homeowners' association is in existence. Since improvements have been completed in the said Scenic Hills Subdivision, a bond will not be required. The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Jean Grapes and passed, did hereby give APPROVAL to the plat of Lot 124A First Revision of Scenic Hills Subdivision, Extension 9, for recordation. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Jean Grapes and passed,


adopted a Resolution in reference to Budget Revision No. 20 in the General County Fund budget for the fiscal year 1995/1996. The Request for Revision to the Approved Budget, being submitted to the Department of Tax and Revenue, Charleston, West Virginia, was signed by Jean Grapes, President of the Wood County Commission. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Jean Grapes and passed, did hereby AUTHORIZE Jean Grapes, in her official capacity as President and on behalf of the County Commission, to sign the letter requesting a budget revision in the Drug Control and System Improvement Grant Number 95-DC-025 (D.A.R.E. Program). The said letter requests that the amount of one thousand five hundred dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$1,500.00) be transferred from the Personnel/Contractual Category to the Other Category to enable the D.A.R.E. Officers within the Wood County Sheriff's Department to purchase additional supplies and materials for the D.A.R.E. Program. The aforementioned letter is being submitted to the Criminal Justice and Highway Safety Division, Charleston, West Virginia. All documentation pertaining to the said Drug Control and System Improvement Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

Having no further business to attend to and no scheduled appointments, the County Commission adjourned at 12:00 Noon.
