ORDER

On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

On this date, the County Commission approved an Erroneous Assessment for Daniel B. & Karen S. Mowery - Vienna District (1995).

On this date, the County Commission approved Personal Property Improvers for Raymond Underwood - Union District (1995); David L. & Patricia L. Kyle - City District (1993); Teknetix - Vienna District (1994 & 1995); and Melody Wallace - Lubeck District (1994).

At 1:00 P.M., the County Commission toured the Magistrate Court Building with Judge Jeffrey B. Reed.

On this date, and pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 51, at Page 433 and bearing the date of April 1, 1991, dealing with the procedure policy for appointments to Boards and Authorities, the county Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by Steven A. Grimm and made unanimous by Jean Grapes, appointed Roy L. Radabaugh to the Mineral Wells Public Service District. Said appointment is due to George Kesterson's term expiring on November 30, 1995. Mr. Radabaugh's term will expire November 30, 2001. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of a check in the amount of four thousand ninety-seven dollars and eleven cents (\$4,097.11) from the State of West Virginia

of which the amount of one thousand three hundred thirty-two dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$1,332.00) represents reimbursement to the County for expenses incurred during the month of November, 1995 in regard to the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant Number 94-JJ-3-004. Receipt of said check is pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 56, at Page 361 and bearing the date of December 28, 1995 at which time the Request for Reimbursement was signed by Jean Grapes, President of the Wood County Commission. All documentation pertaining to the said Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of a check in the amount of four thousand ninety-seven dollars and eleven cents (\$4,097.11) from the State of West Virginia of which the amount of two thousand seven hundred sixty-five dollars and eleven cents (\$2,765.11) represents reimbursement to the County for expenses incurred during the months of October and November, 1995 in regard to the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant Number 95-JJ-5-011. Receipt of said check is pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 56, at Page 341 and bearing the date of November 13, 1995 at which time the Request for Reimbursement was signed by Steven A. Grimm, President Pro Tem of the Wood County Commission and is further pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 56, at Page 361 and bearing the date of December 28, 1995 at which time the Request for Reimbursement was signed by Jean Grapes, President of the Wood County Commission. All documentation

pertaining to the said Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and passed, did hereby AUTHORIZE Jean Grapes, in her official capacity as President and on behalf of the County Commission, to sign the Request for Reimbursement in regard to the Drug Control and System Improvement Grant Number 95-DC-025. Expenditures in the amount of three thousand eight hundred eighty-three dollars and ninety-four cents (\$3,883.94) were made by the County during the month of December, 1995 which represents overtime compensation for Sgt. Donald G. Balog and Deputy Carl VanClief of the Wood County Sheriff's Department who have been assigned as the officers to work the D.A.R.E. (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) Program for Wood County, and for supplies purchased in regard to the said D.A.R.E. Grant. However, the Request for Reimbursement is in the amount of three thousand four hundred seventeen dollars and forty-one cents (\$3,417.41) since there is a ten percent (10%) stipulation in the said Grant that requires the said percentage from the County as matching funds. A check in the amount of eighty-six dollars and eighty-two cents (\$86.82) has been received from the Sheriff's Department to compensate an over-expenditure in the supplies category. In addition to the Request for Reimbursement, the Monthly Progress Report and the Project Financial Report are being submitted to the Criminal Justice and Highway Safety Office, Charleston, WV.

All documentation pertaining to the said Drug Control and System Improvement Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


Having no further business to attend to or scheduled appointments, the County Commission adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
