On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

On this date, the County Commission, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Jean Grapes and passed, approved minutes from Thursday, May 16, 1996 and Wednesday, May 22, 1996.

At 10:15 A.M., Douglas E. Lamm was sworn in as Dog Warden/Humane Officer. Shana Modesitt, Karen Huxley and Juliet Taylor were sworn in as Humane Officers for the Parkersburg Humane Society.

Upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed by this Commission, it is hereby ORDERED that the fees for keeping and maintaining prisoners in the Wood County Correctional Center (Jail) for the months of July, August and September, 1996 be \$39.39 per prisoner per day. It is further ORDERED that the appropriate agencies and authorities be notified by forwarding them a copy of the Order that was prepared regarding this matter.


On this date, the County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of a letter from the West Virginia Development Office, Charleston, West Virginia, advising the County Commission of Community Partnership Grant Programs to be considered for funding through the Legislative Digest during the fiscal year 1996/1997. The two projects cited for funding consideration are the Wood County 4-H Camp Grounds Bathroom Improvements in the amount of fifteen thousand

dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$15,000.00) and the West Virginia Oil and Gas Museum in the amount of sixty thousand dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$60,000.00). An "informational sheet" is to be completed for the aforementioned projects and returned to the Community Development Division of the West Virginia Development Office. As stated in the letter received, costs should not be incurred nor commitments made in regard to the above-stated funds until authorization has been received from the Governor of West Virginia, Gaston Caperton. All documentation pertaining to the said Community Partnership Grants is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


Having no further scheduled appointments or further business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
