THURSDAY, MAY 30, 1996

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

At 8:55 A.M., the County Commission, sitting as the Board of Canvassers, upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by Jean and passed, did hereby certify that in the Election held on May 14, 1996, on the official ballot, the various candidates received the following (see attached) votes and the Certificates of results were duly issued to the persons entitled thereto, and that being no contest pending, the Board of Canvassers does hereby declare the Canvass closed.

On this date, the County Commission gave approval to change the parking space marked County Surveyor to County Clerk.

On this date, and pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 51, at Page 433 and bearing the date of April 1, 1991, dealing with the procedure policy for appointments to boards and authorities, the County Commission of Wood County, announced to all concerned that a vacancy exists on the Vienna Public Library Board. Said vacancy is due to the death of Phyllis McGaha on April 27, 1996. Ms. McGaha's term will expire on June 30, 1998. The County Commission, upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver and seconded by Jean Grapes, placed Nancy Roettger in nomination per a letter from Alice C. Thomas, Director, Vienna Public Library. An Order was prepared regarding

this matter.

On this date, and pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 51, at Page 433 and bearing the date of April 1, 1991, dealing with the procedure policy for appointments to Boards and Authorities, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver and seconded by Jean Grapes, appointed Rocky Peck to the Wood County Planning Commission. Mr. Peck will be filling the unexpired term of Jon H. Bango, who was appointed January 1, 1995, but no longer wishes to serve on said Commission. Mr. Peck's term will expire on December 31, 1997. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, and pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 51, at Page 411 and bearing the date of April 1, 1991, dealing with the procedure policy for appointments to Boards and Authorities, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver and seconded by Jean Grapes, appointed Ronald "Jack" Mullenix to the Union Williams Public Service District. Mr. Mullenix will be filling the unexpired term of Richard S. Hines, who resigned May 9, 1996, for personal reasons. Mr. Mullenix's term will expire on November 1, 1996. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and passed, did hereby AUTHORIZE Jean Grapes, in her official capacity as President and on behalf of the County Commission, to sign the Agreement by and between the Simplex Time Recorder Company, Charleston, West Virginia, and the Wood County Commission,

Parkersburg, West Virginia, in regard to the annual testing of the sprinkler systems located in the Wood County Courthouse and the Wood County Judicial Building. Execution of said Agreement is pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 56, at Page 482 and bearing the date of May 23, 1996 at which time the Commission awarded the quote, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, to Simplex Time Recorder Company. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


Having no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 12:00 Noon.


