On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session.

At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission met with Michele Rusen, Prosecuting Attorney and S.F. Greiner, Assessor to discuss Erroneous Assessments. A list of those approved is attached to these minutes.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, ORDERED that Exoneration No. 7467, found in Order Book 56, at Page 539 and bearing the date of September 12, 1996, pertaining to real property be VOIDED due to incorrect tax amounts. As per the Assessor's Office, a new Exoneration will be prepared. Said Exoneration is in the name of Evelyn Rolston and is in Union District. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, ORDERED that Exoneration No. 7316, found in Order Book 56, at Page 538 and bearing the date of September 12, 1996, pertaining to real property be VOIDED due to an incorrect ticket number. As per the Assessor's Office, a new Exoneration will be prepared. Said Exoneration is in the name of Keith L. & Eloise J. Smith and is in City District. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

At 10:00 A.M., Gordon Skeen was sworn in as a Deputy Sheriff for

the Wood County Sheriff's Department.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of a check in the amount of seven hundred twenty-one dollars and forty-nine cents (\$721.49) from the State of West Virginia which represents reimbursement to the County for expenses incurred during the month of August, 1996 in regard to the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant Number 95-JJ-5-011. Receipt of said check is pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 56, at Page 547 and bearing the date of September 23, 1996 at which time the Request for Reimbursement was signed by Jean Grapes, President of the Wood County Commission. All documentation pertaining to the said Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


Having no scheduled appointments or further business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
