

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD  
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 1996

On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission met with Developer Jeff Campbell to discuss the proposed Civic Center in Parkersburg.

At 10:30 A.M., James E. Crawford was sworn in as a Reserve Deputy for the Wood County Sheriff's Department.

At 1:30 P.M., the County Commission met with John Lichiello, Wood County Solid Waste Authority; Mike St.Clair, Wood County Emergency Services; Cindy Musser, Department of Environmental Protection; and Leonard Sellers, West Virginia State Fire Marshal's Office; who discussed the Clean Up Ordinance for Wood County.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, ORDERED that Exoneration No. 7466, found in Order Book 56, at Page 540 and bearing the date of September 12, 1996, pertaining to personal property be VOIDED due to the fact it is Real Property not Personal Property. As per the Assessor's Office, a new Exoneration will be prepared. Said Exoneration is in the name of Clifford Rolston and is in Union District. The County Commission approved an Erroneous Assessment on Real Property for Clifford Rolston - Union District (1996), No. 7281.

On this date, and pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 51, at Page 433 and bearing the date of April 1, 1991, dealing with

the procedure policy for appointments being made by the County Commission of Wood County; the County Commission announced to all concerned that a vacancy will exist on the Central Boaz Public Service District Board on October 1, 1996. Said vacancy is due to the expiration of Ronnell Foose's term on said date. The new term will expire October 1, 2002. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Steven A. Grimm, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and made unanimous by Jean Grapes, did hereby ORDER that the bid be let for the replacement of the wallpaper throughout the Wood County Courthouse. Specifications for such replacement are incomplete at this time. However, at such time as the specifications have been completed, a Class II Legal Notice will be placed in both local newspapers, The Parkersburg News and The Parkersburg Sentinel, requesting sealed bids be submitted. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, came Michele Rusen, Prosecuting Attorney for Wood County and informed the Commission that Susan Mollohan stands charged with a felony. The said Susan Mollohan was being held by authorities in Marysville, Ohio. It was therefore necessary that Detective K.L. Miller and Detective M.W. Wright travel to Marysville, Ohio and pick up Susan Mollohan and return her to Wood County. Expenditures for said round trip from Parkersburg to Marysville and return cost \$22.02. It appearing property to do so, it is hereby ORDERED that a check be issued in the amount of \$22.02 to Detective K.L. Miller.


