On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

On this date, the County Commission approved Erroneous Assessment Applications in regard to Real Property for Gladys Stewart - Union District (1994, 1995 & 1996); Shala H. Larrabee Trust - Union District (1994 & 1996). The County Commission also approved an Erroneous Assessment in regard to Personal Property for Chester R. Cottrill, II - City District (1992).

On this date, the County Commission, upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by Steven A. Grimm (former Commissioner) and passed, approved minutes from Monday, December 30, 1996.

At 9:15 A.M., the County Commission met with Nathan Peters to discuss the Mineral Wells Incorporation. Mr. Peters stated that they are bringing the map back and want detailed specifics of what they need since this was turned down before so they can make it right. Michele Rusen, attorney for citizens to incorporate, was present and stated that once the map is presented, the County Commission has to have a hearing. Mr. Tebay stated that the citizens haven't met the requirements from the State code. Ms. Rusen agreed but thinks that these are mixing with the survey; there is a case that relaxes those

requirements, it states that a ground survey is not required. The County Commission suggested Ms. Rusen meet with the Prosecutor's Office to work something out on this. More discussion took place. Glenn Neal arrived at this time. Ms. Rusen stated she wasn't sure if Mr. Neal had seen the case in regard to incorporation. Mr. Neal stated he had not. Bill Ambrose was present. The County Commission asked Mr. Neal to expeditiously find out what the Commission needs from the citizens of Mineral Wells. Mr. Ambrose spoke.

At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission held a Public Hearing on the Enhanced 911 for Wood County. Said meeting was held in City Council chambers. To listen to this public hearing, please refer to Tape #30A.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Robert K. Tebay, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and passed, having ascertained that the net amount necessary to be raised by The Levy of Taxes for the Current Year for County current purposes will be nine million one hundred fifty-six thousand two hundred forty-three dollars and 00/100th cents (\$9,156,243.00) according to the estimate and entered of record on the 10th day of April, 1997. Said estimate having been published as required by law, and no one appearing to oppose this Commission or to take exception thereto, and the State Tax Commissioner having heretofore by a letter received by this Commission on the 9th day of April, 1997, approved said Levy Estimate as submitted, it is therefore ORDERED that said Estimate and the Rate of Levy proposed therein, be approved and the following levies be laid on each One Hundred Dollars valuation of each Class

of Property:

11.09 cents of Class I Property

22.18 cents of Class II Property

44.36 cents of Class III Property

44.36 cents of Class IV Property

An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of the Summary Statements from United National Bank, Parkersburg, West Virginia, for the Repair Fund and the Revenue Fund in regard to the Wood County, West Virginia Industrial Development Revenue Bonds, 1980 Series A (Kroger Co. Project). The aforementioned Summary Statements are for the period of January 1, 1997 through March 31, 1997. All documentation pertaining to the said Industrial Development Revenue Bonds is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

Having no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 12:00 Noon.
