On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and correspondence.

On this date, the County Commission approved eight (8) Erroneous Assessment Applications regarding personal property for: J & W Machine Co. in City District for 1998; William R. & Terri A. Little in City District for 1997; Carl D. Cochran, Jr. in Harris District for 1998; Clinton W. & Marilyn J. Kirk in Lubeck District for 1998; Viking Freight, Inc. in Slate District for 1998; Louise E. Cochran in Union District for 1998; LDI Corporation in Vienna District for 1997 and China Max, c/o Ernie Yip in Vienna District for 1998.

On this date, the County Commission approved three (3) Erroneous Assessment Applications regarding real property for: Homer Whited in Vienna District in 1998; Paul M. & Mary K. Full in Williams District for 1998 and O.W. & Donna S. McCune in Williams District for 1998.

On this date, the County Commission authorized David A. Couch, as President, to sign the letter addressed to the Criminal Justice Services requesting a transfer of funds in the amount of two thousand dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$2000.00) in regard to the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant Number 96-JJ-Y-064. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, upon a motion made by Robert K. Tebay, seconded by David A. Couch and passed, did give APPROVAL to the State Board of Education to locate a modular classroom on the site on which is located the West Central Regional Juvenile Detention Center, Mission Drive, Parkersburg, West Virginia. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission appointed Cynthia Buskirk and Sandra Baker to the Wood County Bicentennial Committee. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of a check in the amount of two thousand six hundred ninety nine dollars and twenty six cents (\$2699.26) from the State of West Virginia which represents reimbursement in regard to the STOP Violence Against Women Grant Number 96-VAW-001. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

At 10:00 A.M., Gary Hamilton and Tate Hayman from the Mid Ohio Valley Board of Health met with the Commission.

At 11:00 A.M., Jerry Dotson met with the County Commission regarding Union Williams Public Service District sewer project.

On this date, Lucas W. Mace was sworn in as a Correctional Officer at the Wood County Correctional Center.

On this date, Philip Sturm was sworn in as a member of the Wood County Bicentennial Committee.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant Agreement as approved by the Division of Criminal Justice Services (Grant Number 98-JJR-130). An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission adopted a Resolution in reference to Budget Revision No. 2 in the General County Fund Budget for the fiscal year 1998/1999. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, upon a motion duly made and passed, the County Commission of Wood County ORDERED that the Cease and Desist Work Order of June 8, 1998, in regard to the Wyndemere Subdivision, be vacated and rescinded and further ORDERED that the Developer satisfy the City of Vienna as it relates to the pipe that needs to be placed there.
