On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed invoices and other correspondence.

At 9:00 A.M., the Commission met with Ron Jalbert regarding Senate Bill 179. He wants the Commission to approve the volunteer handicapped parking enforcement team on a county wide basis. At the present time, it is a \$100.00 fine for parking in a handicapped parking space. Mr. Jalbert will be discussing this plan with the City of Parkersburg.

On this date, Mary Edge, Daniel Mace and Melanie Richards were sworn in as temporary part-time employees in the Sheriff's Tax Office.

On this date, the County Commission re-appointed Charles Graham to the West Virginia Little Kanawha River Parkway Authority. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission re-appointed Willis Ridenour to the Wood County Solid Waste Authority. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

At 10:00 A.M. the County Commission held a hearing regarding the Clinton and Vera Kreimer Estates.

On this date, the County Commission gave permission to the West Central Regional Juvenile Detention Center located on Mission Drive, Parkersburg, WV, to construct a twelve (12') foot by twenty-four foot (24') outbuilding on property owned by the County Commission. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of a check in the amount of eight thousand three hundred three dollars and ninety-three cents (\$8303.93) from the State of West Virginia, of which the amount of six thousand nineteen dollars and sixty-one cents (\$6019.61) represents reimbursement to Wood County for expenses incurred during the months of March and April, 1998, in regard to the STOP Violence Against Women Grant Number 96-VAW-001. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission authorized David A. Couch, as President, to execute the Request for Reimbursement in regard to the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant Number 96-JJ-Y-064 in the amount of eighty-five dollars and 00/100ths (\$85.00). An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of a check in the amount of eight thousand three hundred three dollars and ninety-three cents (\$8303.93) from the State of West Virginia of which the amount of two thousand seventy-four dollars and thirty-two cents (\$2074.32) represents reimbursement to Wood County for expenses incurred during the month of April, 1998, in regard to the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant Number 97-JJ-Y-065. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of the Abstracts From The Records of the Commissioner's Orders from the West Virginia Department of Transportation. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of a check in the amount of eight thousand three hundred three dollars and ninety-three cents (\$8303.93) from the State of West Virginia, of which the amount of two hundred ten dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$210.00) represents reimbursement to Wood County for expenses incurred during the month of April, 1998, in regard to


the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant Number 96-JJ-YT-020. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


Having no other scheduled appointments or any other business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 12:00 Noon.


