On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and correspondence.

On this date, the County Commission approved an Erroneous Assessment Application regarding personal property for Robert R. Wilson in Union District for 1998.

On this date, the County Commission approved ten (10) Erroneous Assessment Applications regarding real property for: Gihon Unity Apartments, Inc. in City District for 1996, 1997 and 1998; Unity Housing, Inc. in City District for 1996 (2), 1997 (2), and 1998 (2); and Diana L. Rea in Vienna District for 1998.

At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County certified the election results upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver and seconded by David A. Couch and passed.

Steve Grimm, Assessor, explained to the County Commission regarding the exonerations of Gihon and Unity Plaza. There was a Supreme Court ruling regarding this matter.

At 10:00 A.M., Bill Pugh and Ida McMullen met with the County Commission regarding the Wood County Sports Association.

At 11:00 A.M., the County Commission held a hearing regarding the Ruth Shaffer Estate.

At 11:30 A.M., the County Commission met with Kathryn Drost, who presented the audit of the West Virginia Interstate Fair & Exposition.

On this date, the County Commission ORDERED that a Proclamation be signed proclaiming November 15, 1998, as AMERICA RECYCLES DAY. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of a check in the amount of one thousand seven hundred fifty one dollars and fifty one cents (\$1751.51) from the State of West Virginia which represents reimbursement in regard to the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant Number 96-JJ-Y-064. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission placed John Altman in nomination to fill a vacancy that exists on the Mid-Ohio Valley Board of Health. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission authorized David A. Couch, as President, to execute the Request for Reimbursement in regard to the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant Number 98-JJR-130 in the amount of one thousand three hundred two dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$1302.00). An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission authorized David A. Couch, as President, to sign the Invoice and Request for Funds in the amount of four thousand dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$4000.00) from the Department of Health and Human Resources, Charleston, West Virginia, in regard to the Substance Abuse Intervention Grant Program Q.U.I.T. (Quality Intervention and Treatment). An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

Having no other scheduled appointments or any further business to attend to, the County Commission of Wood County adjourned at 12:00 Noon.
