MONDAY, OCTOBER 5, 1998

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and correspondence.

On this date, the County Commission approved three Erroneous Assessment Applications regarding personal property for Ronald & Bobbie Jo Crites in Parkersburg District for 1998; Leaseco Equipment & Trailer Service in Williams District for 1997 and 1998.

An unidentified man met with the County Commission regarding a problem of junk cars, 4 wheelers, etc. on Victory Street. He also requested the road be graded to fix the large pot holes. The County Commission explained they had nothing to do with roads, he would have to contact the State Road. The County Commission will refer this problem to D.R. Smith.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of a check in the amount of thirty nine dollars and thirty six cents (\$39.36) from the State of West Virginia which represents reimbursement in regard to the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant Number 96-JJ-A-064. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission authorized David A. Couch, as President, to execute the Request for Reimbursement in regard to the STOP Violence Against Women Grant Number 97-VAW-008 in the amount of one thousand nine hundred eighty nine dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$1989.00). An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission authorized David A. Couch, as President, to execute the Grant Agreement by and between the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources, Bureau for Children and Families, Office of Social Services and the Wood County Commission in regard to an Early Intervention and Family Support Services Grant Program (Q.U.I.T.) Quality Intervention and Treatment in the amount of sixteen thousand dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$16,000.00). An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission authorized David A. Couch, as President, to execute the Agreement by and between the West Virginia Commission on Drunk Driving Prevention and the Wood County Commission in regard to a grant in the amount of nineteen thousand nine hundred ninety two dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$19,992.00) for the purpose of drunk driving prevention and/or enforcement. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, GRANTED a time extension of fifteen (15) days for the completion of the appraisal of HCA Columbia/St. Joseph's Hospital being performed by Professional Residential Commercial Appraisers, Inc. of Parkersburg, West Virginia with the completion date now being November 23, 1998. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and made unanimous by David A. Couch, the minutes of June 26, 1997 and July 10, 1997, were approved.

On this date, upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and passed, approved the minutes of June 30, 1997.

On this date, upon a motion made by David A. Couch, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and passed, approved the minutes of July 3, 1997.

On this date, upon a motion made by Robert K. Tebay, seconded by David A. Couch and passed, approved the minutes of July 7, 1997.


Having no other scheduled appointments or any further business to attend to, the County Commission of Wood County adjourned at 4:00 P.M.


