IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD
MONDAY, OCTOBER 26, 1998

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, met in regular session. They signed one purchase order, invoices and correspondence.

On this date, the County Commission approved two (2) Erroneous Assessment Applications regarding real property for Try Again Homes in Parkersburg District for 1996 and 1997.

On this date, the County Commission approved an Erroneous Assessment Application regarding personal property for Howard L. Rowsey in Williamstown District for 1997.

At 9:30 A.M., Tim Tiano met with the County Commission to discuss an underage drinking grant. This grant, known as the Sober Program (Services, Observation, Behavior Modification, Education and Rehabilitation) is in the amount of thirty thousand seven hundred sixty dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$37,600.00) with an in kind match in the amount of six thousand dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$6000.00) to be provided by the Counseling Agency, Juvenile Probation Office, Wood County Schools, Law Enforcement Agencies and Wood County Prosecuting Attorney's Office. This grant period would begin January 1, 1999 and continue through December 31, 1999. Upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and passed, the County Commission authorized David A. Couch, as President, to execute a Resolution to authorize the filing of an application for a grant with the West Virginia Department of Military Affairs and Public Safety, Criminal Justice Services Division, Charleston, West Virginia, for the purpose of applying

for a combating underage drinking grant, known as the Sober Program. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission held a hearing regarding the William P. Smith Estate.

On this date, the County Commission appointed Caroline Hawkinberry to the Wood County Bicentennial Committee. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of a check in the amount of five thousand four hundred fourteen dollars and thirty six cents (\$5414.36) from the United States Treasury which represents reimbursement for the 75% Federal portion of the Cops Universal Hiring Program Grant Number 96-UM-WX-1285. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission authorized David A. Couch, as President, to execute the Letter of Understanding between the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources and the Wood County Commission in regard to the Early Intervention and Family Support Services Grant, Project Q.U.I.T. (Quality Intervention and Treatment). An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

At 1:30 P.M., the County Commission went to the Circuit Clerk's Office to pack and seal the official computer ballot cards and sample ballots to be delivered to individual Precinct Commissioners for the General Election to be held November 3, 1998. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.



At 3:00 P.M., the County Commission checked the computer in the County Commission Office.


Having no other scheduled appointments or any further business to attend to, the County Commission of Wood County adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
