On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and correspondence.

At 9:30 A.M., Steve Nicely and Dave Ashley from the Convention and Visitors Bureau met with the County Commission. They discussed their new publications for this coming year.

At 10:00 A.M., Chief Gary Deem, the Mayors of Parkersburg and Vienna and the Sheriff met with the County Commission to discuss volunteers to collect information on illegal parking in handicap spaces.

At 10:45 A.M., Joe Bobier of Wire Fire Internet Service, Mark Rhodes and Jamie Six met with the County Commission to discuss election results being put on the internet.

At 11:00 A.M., Grace Taylor-Kirby met with the County Commission to discuss West Virginia Special Olympics. She is the new Director and wanted to explain what will be happening with the Special Olympics.

At 11:30 A.M., Bill Yoke met with the County Commission to discuss the E911 progress.

On this date, the County Commission approved Change Order Number One (1) as submitted by WYK Associates, Inc. and Schneider Construction Company in regard to the Conversion of the Core Road Elementary School to the Wood County E911 Facility and authorized David A. Couch, as President, to execute this Change Order. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission authorized David A. Couch, as President, to execute an Agreement with the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources, Bureau for Children and Families and the Office of Social Services regarding Grant Titled Quality Intervention and Treatment (Q.U.I.T.) An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of a check in the amount of three thousand eight hundred seventy six dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$3876.00) from the State of West Virginia which represents reimbursement in regard to the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant Number 98-JJ-R-130. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of a petition signed by members of the Multiple Sclerosis Support Group of the Mid-Ohio Valley who endorse the new proposed countywide ordinance regarding enforcement of handicap parking by a force of volunteer citizens. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

On this date, the County Commission was in receipt of a check in the amount of one hundred fifty six dollars and twenty six cents (\$156.26) from the State of West Virginia which represents reimbursement for expenditures incurred in the extradition of Brian Hisgen from Kentucky to West Virginia. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


On this date, the County Commission appointed Shawn Butcher to the Wood County Bicentennial Committee. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


