IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD
MONDAY, DECEMBER 9, 1999

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

The County Commission approved an Erroneous Assessment Application in regard to Real Property for Alex & Gina L. Karwatka - Williamstown District (1999).

At 9:30 A.M., John W. Sweeney, Petitioner, representing himself, presented to the County Commission of Wood County a Petition to close .6 of a mile of Road $\frac{3}{4}$ starting at Route 31 and continuing to a point designated by ribbons tied to trees at the last point requiring access by any other individuals in the area. The aforementioned Petition was signed by John W. Sweeney, Donna S. Sweeney, Dennis Cosner and Verna Cosner, the only residents that gain access via the first three hundred feet (300') of the aforementioned Road $\frac{3}{4}$. The remainder of Road $\frac{3}{4}$, stated Petitioner Sweeney, is not being Petitioned to be closed due to the fact that property owners requiring access to their undeveloped land is currently passable with a four-wheel drive vehicle. The reasons stated by the Petitioner for such request to close a portion of the Road $\frac{3}{4}$ are security, privacy, and safety. The said Road $\frac{3}{4}$ is located in Williams Taxing District, Wood County, West Virginia. After reviewing the tax map and Petition to close the aforementioned Road $\frac{3}{4}$, the County Commission of Wood County, by unanimous vote, decided to view the area at 10:30 A.M. on Monday, December

13, 1999. The County Commission of Wood County did hereby ORDER that the aforementioned Petition be filed. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

Commissioner Couch announced that Sammy Burdette would like to serve on the Workforce Committee.


The County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of a check in the amount of four thousand one hundred seven dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$4,107.00) from the State of West Virginia which represents reimbursement to Wood County for expenses incurred during the months of July, August and September, 1999 in regard to the Victims Assistance Formula Grant Number 98-VA-019. Receipt of the aforementioned check is pursuant to an ORDER appearing in Order Book 64, at Page 67 and bearing the date of August 19, 1999; pursuant to an ORDER appearing in Order Book 64, at Page 81 and bearing the date of September 13, 1999; and pursuant to an ORDER appearing in Order Book 64, at Page 108 and bearing the date of October 21, 1999 at which time Holmes R. Shaver, in his official capacity as President and on behalf of the County Commission, was AUTHORIZED to EXECUTE the Requests for Reimbursement. Documentation pertaining to the Victims Assistance Formula Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by David A. Couch, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and passed, placed Larry Godfrey in nomination for reappointment to the Wood County Parks and Recreation Commission. The County Commission, upon a motion made by David A. Couch, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and passed, placed Howard Linger and Jay B. Wilson in nomination for appointment to the Wood County Parks and Recreation Commission. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

Having no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission
adjourned at 12:00 Noon.
