On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed invoices and other correspondence.

On this date, the County Commission approved Erroneous Assessments in regard to Personal Property for Charles R. VanClief - Vienna District (1996) and for William K. Young - City District (1997).

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of a check in the amount of seven thousand eight hundred twenty dollars and eighty-five cents (\$7,820.85) from the State of West Virginia of which the amount of three hundred seventy-two dollars and forty-eight cents (\$372.48) represents reimbursement to Wood County for expenses incurred during the month of December, 1998 in regard to the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant Number 96-JJ-A-064. Receipt of said check is pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 60, at Page 523 and bearing the date of January 11, 1999 at which time the Request for Reimbursement was signed by Robert K. Tebay, President Pro Tem of the Wood County Commission. All documentation pertaining to the said Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator.


On this date, the County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of a check in the amount of seven thousand eight hundred twenty dollars and eight-five cents (\$7,820.85) from the State of West Virginia of which the amount of five thousand eight hundred eighty-eight dollars and

thirty-seven cents (\$5,888.37) represents reimbursement to Wood County for expenses incurred during the Month of October, 1998 in regard to the STOP Violence Against Women Grant Number 97-VAW-008. Receipt of said check is pursuant to an ORDER appearing in Order Book 60, at Page 503 and bearing the date of November 23, 1998, at which time David A. Couch, in his official capacity as President and on behalf of the County Commission, was AUTHORIZED to EXECUTE the Request For Reimbursement. Documentation pertaining to the aforementioned STOP Violence Against Women Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

Having no scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 12:00 Noon.
