At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission met with Susan Galvin, Sharon Lynch and John Canfield to discuss the S.A.F.E. Team.


At 10:30 A.M., the County Commission met with Ronald Talkington who wished to discuss the clean up of property on Turkey Foot Road.
