On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

Commissioner-Elect Merritt was present for these meetings.

Chief Charlie Johnson was present and discussed the purchase of new cruisers and the new 4-wheel drive for the incoming Sheriff. The County Commission then held a conference call with Ginny Conley, Prosecuting Attorney, to discuss the legality of the holiday pay for Deputies and Correctional Officers.

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, at 10:15 A.M., but was scheduled for 10:00 A.M. pursuant to the legal notice, opened sealed bids for a dump truck to be utilized by the Wood County Maintenance Department. 


The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, did hereby take the aforementioned bids under advisement. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.
