IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD  
MONDAY, JULY 31, 2000

On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

From 9:30 A.M. to 11:00 A.M., the County Commission entertained a retirement party for Mary Shuman from the Sheriff's Tax Office. They presented her with a Certificate and a set of Bicentennial coins.

The County Commission, upon a motion made by David A. Couch, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and made unanimous by Holmes R. Shaver, approved minutes from June 8, 2000 and June 12, 2000. The County Commission, upon a motion made by David A. Couch, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and passed, approved minutes from June 15, 2000.

At 1:30 P.M., the County Commission met with Carol Barth, Juvenile Probation Office; Kelly Earley, Project Coordinator for the S.O.B.E.R. Program and Toni Tiano, Grant Consultant. The County Commission, upon a motion made by David A. Couch, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and passed, did hereby AUTHORIZE Holmes R. Shaver, in his official capacity as President and on behalf of the County Commission, to EXECUTE the AGREEMENT by and between Kelly C. Earley, 2716 - 25<sup>th</sup> Street, Parkersburg, West Virginia, and the County Commission of Wood County, Wood County, West Virginia, in regard to the Combating Underage Drinking Program Grant Number 98-UD-005. The County Commission is the recipient of grant funds from the State of West Virginia's Office of Military Affairs and Public Safety, Criminal Justice Services,

Enforcing the Underage Drinking Laws Grant Program, for the purpose of hiring a Project Coordinator for the S.O.B.E.R. (Services, Observation, Behavior Modification, Education, and Rehabilitation) Program through the Wood County Juvenile Probation Office. Kelly C. Earley, hired as the Project Coordinator, will direct the activities of the S.O.B.E.R. Program in Wood County, which will include Program Accountability, Project Coordination, Fiscal Management, Public Relations, Meetings, and other duties necessary for the proper administration, and oversight of the S.O.B.E.R. Program. For these services, the County Commission of Wood County, through the aforementioned Grant funds, shall compensate the said Kelly C. Earley, at the rate of thirteen dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$13.00) per hour for up to forty (40) hours per week for up to sixteen (16) weeks for a maximum amount of twenty-six thousand dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$26,000.00). The said S.O.B.E.R. Program Grant provides funds in the amount of ten thousand dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$10,000.00) to develop a public education and information campaign; and funds in the amount of three thousand dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$3,000.00) for local travel and for in-state and out-of-state travel and training. The aforementioned AGREEMENT shall commence on July 1, 2000 and will terminate on June 30, 2001. The terms contained in the aforementioned AGREEMENT may be modified or amended at any time by mutual consent of the County Commission, Kelly C. Early, and the Criminal Justice Services, Charleston, West Virginia. Documentation pertaining to the Combating Underage Drinking Program Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator.


The County Commission, upon a motion made by Robert K. Tebay, seconded by David A. Couch and made unanimous by Holmes R. Shaver, and in accordance with Chapter Seven, Article One, Section Three-ff of the code of West Virginia, appointed Robert Eddy to the Abandoned Building Ordinance Enforcement Agency. Said appointment is due to the expiration of William

Ferguson's term on July 23, 1999. Mr. Eddy's term will expire July 23, 2002. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


Having no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
