THURSDAY, MAY 18, 2000

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission held a hearing in regard to Robert Strickland, incompetent. Sue Ann Hill and Rita D. Moss were present. This hearing was continued, upon a motion made by David A. Couch, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and made unanimous by Holmes R. Shaver, to May 22, 2000 at 10:30 A.M. Information in regard to this hearing is on file in the Probate Office.

At 10:30 A.M., the county Commission finalized the canvass of the election held May 9, 2000.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, did hereby AUTHORIZE Holmes R. Shaver, in his official capacity as President and on behalf of the County Commission, to EXECUTE the Financial Status Report in regard to the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Number 96-LB-VX-1665. The said Grant period began October 1, 1996 and continued through September 30, 1998. The Federal Outlay was in the amount of twelve thousand six hundred seventy dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$12,670.00) and Wood County's outlay was in the amount of one thousand four hundred seven dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$1,407.00). The aforementioned Grant funds were expended on five (5) computer stations for use in the Wood


County Sheriff's Department. In addition to the aforementioned Financial Status Report, the LLEBG Final Progress Report is being submitted to the Bureau of Justice Assistance, Washington, DC. Documentation pertaining to the aforementioned Local Law Enforcement Block Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by David A. Couch, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and passed, did hereby AUTHORIZE Holmes R. Shaver, in his official capacity as President and on behalf of the County Commission, to sign the request for a six-month extension in regard to the Cops Fast Hiring Grant Number 96-UM-WX-1285. Without the aforementioned request for extension, the Grant would expire June 30, 2000. The aforementioned request is being submitted to the Office of Community Oriented Policing Services, U.S. Department of Justice, Washington, D.C. Documentation pertaining to the COPS Fast Hiring Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

Having no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 12:00 Noon.
