At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in Special Session for the canvassing of the General Election held Tuesday, November 7, 2000.

At 11:04 A.M., Tina Kesterson and Shuan Butcher informed the County Commission that they had finished the hand count of Precinct 15.

At 12:00 A.M., they adjourned for lunch.

After everyone returned, they reconvened at 1:15 P.M.

At 1:30 P.M., Dean Lewis and Linda Bonnett informed the County Commission that they had finished hand count of Precinct 23. Linda Bonnett filled in for Donna Lucas, who had started the hand count with Mr. Lewis.

At 1:50 P.M., Marcia Monroe and Susan Williamson informed the County Commission that they had finished the hand count of Precinct 49. Also at this time Tessa Miller and Emma Poe informed the County Commission they had finished the hand count of Precinct 38.


Jamie Six informed the County Commission that with the final hand counts completed they are within the 1% error margin.
