



At 1:30 P.M., the County Commission met in Special Session. After discussion with Francis Guffey, Architect and Mary Rader, County Administrator, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Robert K. Tebay, seconded by David A. Couch, and made unanimous by Holmes R. Shaver, did hereby ORDER that the bid for the asbestos removal and the demolition of the building located at 300 Market Street, Parkersburg, WV (former Sid's Building) be AWARDED to J.C. Bosley Construction, Inc., Mineral Wells, WV. The aforementioned motion is pursuant to an ORDER appearing in Order Book 64, at Page 326 and bearing the date of September 28, 2000, at which time the County Commission opened sealed bids and upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed took the bids under advisement. Bids for the aforementioned asbestos removal and the demolition of the building located at 300 Market Street, Parkersburg, WV, are on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter. Also in attendance was Jeff Saultan from *The Parkersburg News*.
